Objectives & Topics:

This course is specifically designed for those who require retraining in ICAO dangerous goods topics to meet the DOT and ICAO training and testing regulations. A review of the Dangerous Goods Regulations, including all new regulatory amendments, will take place followed by work exercises and scenarios. A written test will complete the course.
